St. Mary's Catholic School - Summer Math Assignment – Rising Sixth Grade - 2020

We will be using Prodigy for our summer Math program for those students entering 6th grade. You all know what an awesome program this is. This will be a mandatory program. Your first Math grade of 6th grade will be a participation grade for summer Prodigy.

Here's the plan:

Each week you will complete an assignment of 25 problems. You can do them all at once or you can complete 5 a day, but they must be completed during the assigned week to earn all points for that assessment. All the assessments will be reviews of the material learned in 5th grade. This way you will keep your skills sharp.

We will begin our quest on June 15. It will end the week of August 3. The good news is that if you take a week off for vacation you can still get credit. The last week is a bonus week. By the end of the summer you should have completed 200 problems. That's the goal. Of course, the more you do, the easier 6th grade will be.

Your grade will be determined by how many problems you complete each week. So, if you do 25 problems each week, by August 7th you will be done. I will send you updates with your status periodically. I encourage you to complete the problems weekly, since each week we will be reviewing different material. Again, this is not optional, but it should be an easy way to keep your math skills sharp.

Set a time to play with your friends, beat the wizards and make a 100. Have fun! Let the games begin,
