

Middle School Math Challenge for Summer 2023

At SMS we encourage our students to keep their math skills sharp by continuing to work on **Prodigy** throughout the summer. The best way to maintain skills is by weekly practice.

Prodigy is an excellent program that lets each student work at their own pace to continue to build skills. For the more advanced students the level of difficulty increases. For those needing review, questions will be at the student's level to help the build confidence. Laura Leahy (middle school math teacher) is able to view the progress students are making and monitor their weekly activity in the program.

Our summer challenge for Middle School students is to complete 200 problems or more by August 14, 2023.

- All students who complete 200 problems will receive a prize. That's only 20 problems a week!
- We will also recognize the student in each grade that completes the MOST problems this summer.
- For every 100 problems a student completes ABOVE the original 200, your child's name will be entered in a drawing for a grand prize. Winners will be announced on the first day of school.

Students may use any device that has internet, including phones.

Steps to Getting on Prodigy on a New Device

1. Type in "play prodigy" in a URL search bar.
2. Click on Google.
3. Use your school email address and password to login.
4. Enter the class code for your upcoming grade.
